

SHORT BIOGRAPHY

Antonio Pescapè is a Full Professor at the Department of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology and Rector Delegate for Innovation and Third Mission of the University of Napoli Federico II (Italy).

He received the M.S. Laurea Degree in Computer Engineering and the Ph.D. in Computer Engineering and Systems, both at University of Napoli Federico II. He is director of ERMES (European Research Centre on Media for E-Society) and Scientific Director of DIGITA Academy both founded at the University of Napoli Federico II. Antonio Pescapè is the Principal Investigator and the Coordinator of the research group of the Department of Electrical Engineering and

Information Technology of the Università di Napoli Federico II called Traffic. For his research activities has received more than 20 awards. Among them, he was awarded by Open Source Software World Challenge, the IRTF ANRP (Applied Networking Research Prize), the Google Faculty Award for the UBICA (User-Based Internet Censorship Analysis) research project, the AWS (Amazon Web Service) Education Grant Award and the Microsoft Azure Research Award. Since 2009, Antonio Pescapè is a Senior Member of IEEE. Antonio Pescapè has participated to more than 30 research projects, with roles of both Coordinator and Member of the research unit. He has been involved in more than 300 among Editorial Boards of Journals as well as Steering Committees and Program Committees of international Conferences.

Antonio Pescapè has co-authored more than 250 publications. He has worked as Independent reviewer of projects and evaluator of project proposals co-funded by European Commission (FP7, Horizon 2020, CHIST-ERA, EIT Health); “la CAIXA Foundation” (Spain); Swedish government; Croatian government; Austrian government (Austrian Science Fund (FWF)); Several Italian local governments (Regione Calabria, Regione Liguria, Regione Puglia, Regione Lazio, Regione Campania); Italian Ministry for University and Research (MIUR, Ministero dell’Istruzione, dell’Università e della Ricerca) in the context of PON, FIRB, EUROSTARS; Italian Ministry for Economic Development (MISE, Ministero dello Sviluppo Economico); Invitalia; Internal Research Projects of Università Ca-foscari; Internal Research Projects of Università di Verona.
